

Paramount Machine Terms and Conditions

This purchase order constitutes buyer's offer to seller and becomes a binding contract upon seller's acceptance. No modification of the terms and conditions herein shall be valid unless in writing and signed by and authorized representative of the buyer and no conditions or additional terms stated by seller in accepting this order shall be binding upon the buyer unless accepted in writing by buyer.

1. **CALIBRATION SYSTEM COMPLIANCE:** Calibration will be performed by a provider having a control system that meets the requirements of ISO 10012, ISO 17025, ANSI/NCSL Z540, or MIL-STD 45662A, or equivalent. Where the calibration provider is the sole source of calibration or the manufacturer of the M& TE being calibrated this requirement becomes a recommendation, but is not required.
2. **U.S GOVERNMENT DEFENSE RATING:** This procurement is rated for National Defense use, issued under the DPAS. Seller is required to follow all provisions of the Defense Priority & Allocation System Regulation (15 CFR part 700). Seller's written acknowledgment of purchase order shall constitute acceptance of the DPAS rating. The DPAS rating shall be flowed down to all sub-tier suppliers.
3. **DFAR:** Unless otherwise noted on the purchase order, all items must conform to DFAR 252.225-7014, Preference for Domestic Specialty Metals, alternate I.
4. **ITAR CONTROLLED:** U.S. export law as contained in the Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) is applicable to information contained on this purchase order. The technical information is not to be placed in the public domain, exported from the U.S., or given to any foreign persons in the U.S. without the prior specific written permission of Paramount Machine, its customer(s) and the U.S. Department of State.
